# **Last Week**

Speaker: Mr Ajit Singh Gill, Singapore's oldest Olympian

Topic: "Heart of an Olympian"

President Keith invited Honorary Member (HM) PP Raymon Huang to introduce his long-time friend, Mr Ajit Singh Gill. HM PP Raymon noted that Mr Gill is known as "Singapore's Sporting Role Model at 90" and is a most accomplished veteran sportsman. He noted that Mr Gill's philosophy and guide to daily living has enabled him to meet adversity with resilience, gratitude, generosity and mindfulness of others, as documented in a book entitled "Heart of an Olympian" written by his grandson, Mr Luc Gill. HM PP Raymon added that Mr Gill represented Singapore in hockey at the 1956 Melbourne Olympics and further advised that the Government awarded Mr Gill with a National Day Award — The Pingat Bakti Setia.

Mr Gill spoke of his humble beginnings in Kuala Lumpur and the hardships endured which he overcame to see his rise to sporting accomplishment as Singapore's oldest Olympian. Mr Gill described the wonderful feeling of being an Olympian and representing Singapore, adding that the experience of being with the best in the world and competing with them was tremendous.

To end his talk, Mr Gill graciously answered questions from members of his life and Olympic experiences as well as the current state of sports in Singapore.

President Keith called upon Rtn Uttam Kripalani who recounted when he first met Mr Gill at the Singapore Island Country Club as a be new golfer for a round of golf with HM PP Bhagwan Melwani and Brig. Gen Kirparam Vij, former Chief of Armed Forces in Singapore. Rtn Uttam added that Mr Gill taught him a good lesson, to enjoy the game by playing positively and totally concentrate on the next shot- not thinking about the last bad shot which will only ruin the next shot and to forget the last mistake. He added that it was a good lesson not only for golf and also for most

things in life. Rtn Uttam warmly thanked Mr Gill for a wonderful speech which highlighted some fascinating features of life in early Malaysia and in sports.
