

Publication of the Rotary Principles and Core Values

The Vocational Service Committee (VSC) 2017/2018 under the chairmanship of PN Deepak Nagrani produced a Pocket Companion entitled "Rotary Principles and Core Values". At the last VSC meeting for the year on 14 June at the Gilmore Room of the Singapore Cricket Club, PDG Dr Philbert Chin the author was invited to present the first copy of the companion to President Keith Harrison.

During the presentation PDG Philbert explained why our District (Rotary District 3310) introduced The Guide to Daily Living as a companion to Rotary International's 4-Way Test. While the 4-Way Test was introduced for businessmen to practise ethics, the Guide to Daily Living promotes the core values of Rotary of Fellowship, Integrity, Service and Diversity. Not only

that the Guide to Daily Living supports, enhance and priorities Rotary's philosophy

of "service", it also put order into the lives of Rotarians.



The publication of the pocket companion which was sponsored by Honorary Member (HM) Mohan Vaswani contains a foreword by HM Raymon Huang, who in it wrote that The Guide to Daily Living or the Guide as we fondly call it, is indeed a very practical guide in our Rotary journey and Road to Service.
