

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM) PROCEEDINGS

President Mark called the AGM to order and noted the three items on the Agenda:

- Adoption of the Club's Audited Financial Statements for year ended 30 June 2017.
- Adoption of the Board of Directors for Rotary Year 2019-2020.
- Adoption of Proposal of Upfront Collection for Weekly Meeting Costs.

President Mark called for the adoption of the Audited Financial Statements for year ended 30 June 2017, proposed by PN Dinesh Sharma and seconded by IPP Keith Harrison, which was formally adopted by a show of hands.

Next, President Mark invited PE Deepak Nagrani to introduce the Board of Directors for Rotary Year 2019/2020. PE Deepak briefly informed members of his resolve to ensure that the year would be less about his presidency and more about the Board. He also highlighted some plans for next year such as Board Speaker series, Member Get Member scheme and New Member process.

Lastly, PE Deepak called on members to save the date for the Installation of the Board on 29 June 2019.

The Board of Directors as indicated above was proposed by PP Paliath "Mohan" Mohandas and seconded by Rtn Atul Merchant, which was formally adopted by a show of hands.

The 3rd item on the Agenda – the Proposal of Upfront Collection for Weekly Meeting Costs was put to the floor. President Mark gave a summary for the rationale to charge 50% upfront billing and collection, with the proposed exceptions for senior members (age + Rotary age = 80 years), Ambassador Members and Honorary Members.

Members shared their opinions of the Proposal. PDG Dr Philbert Chin proposed an amendment to the Proposal - to delete the exception for senior members, which was seconded by PP Mansoor Hassanbhai.

The amended Proposal was put to a vote, by a show of hands – the Proposal was not carried.

Prior to closing the AGM, President Mark thanked members for their participation and views; he added that the Board would continue to look at other areas such as the meeting venues, menu and accessibility for the Club.







Last Week

Speaker: Reverend Melvin Huang

Topic: "Serving God and Humanity: CLASS ACTS"



President Mark called on Honorary Member PP Raymon Huang who was pleased to once more introduce the Speaker – he advised that Rev. Melvin Huang had spoken to the Club before, and was doing so again because he would be retiring at the end of the month. HM PP Raymon advised that Rev. Melvin was his eldest son.

He further advised that Rev. Melvin served

as a Naval Officer in the Republic of Singapore Navy for his National Rev. Melvin, President Mark, HM PP Raymon Service. He added that the iconic thing, Rev. Melvin did during his Navy stint was that he wrote the present Singapoe Navy Song, with some input from DPM Teo Chee Hean, was then the Commander-in-Chief.

Rev. Melvin studied at the University of Singapore for his degree of Bachelor of Business Administration, and The Asbury Theological Seminary, Kentucky USA for his degree of Master in Divinity. Upon graduation, Rev. Melvin served as Paster-in-Charge in the following Methodist Churches (MC) – Trinity MC, Christ MC, Wesley MC and the Ang Mo Kio MC.

Rev. Melvin gave his definition of "Class Acts" adding that the Christmas story reminded us of "class acts" in the examples of Mary and her spouse, Joseph – and of Jesus.

He recounted his personal encounter of a "class act" and kind gesture of his Primary 2 teacher at Anglo-Chinese Junior School in 1963. Rev. Melvin went on to tell members of other "class acts" stories. Rev. Melvin noted that Christmas reminded him of the Holy Family, who was in fact refugees, and how this moved him to be kind to the marginalized.

To conclude his talk, Rev. Melvin led members in singing carols

– Silent Night, Feliz Navidad and We Wish You a Merry
Christmas.

To extend the Club's vote of thanks, President Mark called on Rtn James Lee who warmly thanked Rev. Melvin for his excellent talk.
