## Last Week – Report on the 10<sup>th</sup> Evening Meeting – Wednesday 20 March 2019

As there were no visiting Rotarians, Rtn Horst invited Rtn Sylvia Chung to lead the Club in a toast to Rotary International.



On behalf of the Youth Service Committee, Rtn Paul Phua reported on the successfully completed "Grey Can Still Play" project held on 16 March 2019. He advised that about 200 Interactors from 15 Interact Clubs organised a lunch, entertainment and carnival for about 100 senior citizens.

#### **MAJOR PROJECT 2018-2019**

Rtn Horst called on members' support of the Club's Major Project for the year, adding that President Mark had sent an appeal to all members and leading the way with a generous contribution for the following two beneficiaries:

- Singapore Polytechnic Project to train adolescents with autism for the workplace. The project prepares students to identify their own work values, interest and prepare their resumes. It equips participants with communications skills for interviews and for adapting at the workplace.
- Singapore Repertory Theatre (SRT) The use of drama in conjunction with and participation by students from different service communities. The production would focus on anti-bullying in partnership with Touch Community Services "touch Silent club" which provides community support to deaf students.

Speaker: Mr Liew Heng San

**Board Member of the Singapore Bible College** 

**Topic:** "Gambling: Get Rich Quick"

Rtn Horst called on Rtn Joseph Chia who introduced the Guest Speaker, Mr Liew Heng San. Mr Liew serves on the Board of the Singapore Bible College and as Chairman of the World Vision Singapore Advisory Council, among other corporate responsibilities. Mr Liew Heng San, joined the Administrative Service in 1977 after graduating with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree from Cambridge University on an Overseas Merit Scholarship. He obtained a Masters in Public Administration from Harvard University in 1986.

Mr Liew served a stint in NTUC, where he held the appointments of Executive Director (NTUC Comfort Workshop) and Executive Secretary (Singapore Industrial and Services Employees Union), and worked in the Public Service Commission Secretariat and the Ministry of Trade and Industry before his appointment as Principal Private Secretary to Deputy Prime Minister Lee in 1991. He was appointed Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Communications and Chief Executive Officer, Land Transport Authority in 1995 and Managing Director, Economic Development Board in 1998. Mr Liew has been Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Law since 2001. Before his retirement after over

30 years of public service, he also held the appointment of Chief Executive Officer of the CPF Board.

In his presentation, Mr Liew explained what was an unfair bet via unfair pay-outs and unfair odds. He spoke of problem gambling and the statistical research on gamblers' losses. He presented facts on how addictive gambling was and its druglike effects on the brain. He gave the percentage of Singaporeans gamblers, who are the second biggest gamblers in the world.

Mr Liew graciously answered questions from members and encouraged them to fill in the application form for Casino Self-Exclusion (a copy of this form and Mr Liew's presentation is available from the Secretariat).

Rtn Horst invited Rtn Paul Phua to extend the Club's vote of thanks to Mr. Liew. Rtn Paul noted that Mr Liew's presentation was so well researched and presented with such clarity that it would be difficult for any layman to dispute. He wished that more members were present in order to listen to today's condition of gambling in Singapore.
