
Director Kamal Sanghvi and spouse Sonal hosted an interesting interactive session with Shekhar and Rashi. Shekhar's family joined in highlighting unique aspects of Shekhar's profile.

Past President Kalyan Banerjee, Director Bharath Pandya, Trustee Gulam Vahanavathy and Past Directors YP Das, PT Prabhakar and Manoj Desai felicitated. RIPP Rajendra Saboo felicitated on video. Shekhar's Rotary journey, his commitment and hard work on Rotary causes were highlighted by the speakers. Speakers applauded Shekhar's stellular roles in Literacy, Shelter Kits, Eye Hospitals and other projects.

Rtn Ronald Wong for arranging the Interactors' participation.




# DISTRICT GOVERNOR JEFF YONG'S OFFICIAL VISIT & 2<sup>ND</sup> CLUB ASSEMBLY
