After lunch, the residents were brought on a stroll through the stalls that were set up in Little India for the Diwali celebrations.








Report on Community Service Committee (CSC) Little India Tour...19.10.19

The Little India walk continued from the Indian Heritage Centre through the Diwali stalls and ended at Serangoon Road where the vans came to fetch the residents home.



ITINERARY MAIN PROGRAMME

dd 030ct19

DAY 01, TUE 07 JAN 2020: SINGAPORE - DA NANG ARRIVAL - HUE (L/D)

09.15: Depart Singapore by MI632 for Da Nang

11.00: Arrive in Da Nang, transfer and lunch before drive to Hue. Reach Hue, check into hotel or those keen, visit the **Imperial Citadel** from where the Nguyen dynasty ruled between 1802 and 1945. Some shopping time at the lively **Dong Ba** market

Overnight in Hue (IndoChine Palace Hue 5*)

Meals Lunch at Madame Lan restaurant - Vietnamese Cuisine

Dinner at Royal Park restaurant - Royal Feast Dinner

DAY 02, WED 08 JAN 2020: HUE FULL DAY - ROTARY GG 1746552 & 1982710 PROJECTS (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel & check out, meet PDG Do & transfer to **Vinh Thai commune**, **Phu Vang District**. Following lunch, transfer to **Huong Nguyen Commune**, A Luoi District, Thua Thien Hue Province (60 km far from Hue City). After that, return to hotel in Hue city.

Breakfast at hotel, transfer to **Cam Lo @ Quang Tri province (**90 km far from Hue City ~ 2 hrs' transfer by transportation**)**. After that, return to Hue city for lunch and then transfer to Da Nang

Rotary GG Inspection & Fellowship Trip to Central Vietnam 07 – 10 Jan 2020 (RC Singapore) jointly with RC Marina City & RC Queenstown

DAY 04, FRI 10 JAN 2020: DA NANG - BA NA HILLS- MARBLE MOUNTAIN (B/L/D)



Breakfast at hotel, check out and depart for **Ba Na Hill Station**, at 1,500 msl 48km west of Da Nang. Visit **Old French Villas** enroute as well as **the suspension bridge**, **Nui Chua & the Mountain Peak** (at the height of 1,487m) where we take cable car to Vong Nguyet villa visiting Linh Ung Pagoda, Sakyamuni Buddha statue.

Then visit **Golden Bridge** located in Thien Thai Garden of Sun World Ba Na Hills at 1,414m above sea level. The bridge is connected to the Marseille and Bordeaux stations taking guests from the foot of the mountain of the French village to the flower garden. The bridge looking like a brilliant silk is 150 m in length, including 8 spans, the longest span being 21.2m.

Visit the Fantasy Park - Ba Na Hills Fantasy Park - third largest indoor amusement park in the world and free time around Ba Na Hill till we go down to the foot of mountain.

After lunch, transfer back to **Danang** Enroute visit Marble Mountain "five elements mountains", a cluster of five marble (**Kim - metal; Moc - wood; Thuy - water; Hoa - fire; Tho - earth**) and limestone hills located in **Ngu Hanh Son** ward.

Overnight in Danang (Hyatt Regency Da Nang Resort & Spa)

Meals Breakfast at hotel

Buffet Lunch in Bana Hill - Vietnamese Cuisine

Dinner at Full Moon restaurant or similar - Vietnamese Cuisine

DAY 05, SAT 11 JAN 2020: DA NANG - HOI AN - ANCIENT TOWN (B/L/D)

Breakfast and transfer to Hoi an Ancient Town for sights visiting Family Chapel built by prominent, merchant or official families as the center of ancestor worship, a Chinese style Pagoda or Assembly Hall: Japanese Covered Bridge Pagoda constructed in 1593 by Japanese community of Hoi An to link the Town with the Chinese Quarter across the stream, Fukien Association temple, Ceramic Museum and Chua Ong Temple.

Overnight in Hoi An (Almanity Hoi An Wellness Resort)

Meals Breakfast at hotel

Lunch at Lantern restaurant or similar - Vietnamese Cuisine

Dinner at Home Villa Hoi An restaurant or similar - Vietnamese Cuisine

Distance Hoi An - Danang: 35 km → 35 minutes' transfer

DAY 06, SUN 12 JAN 2020: HOI AN – DA NANG – SINGAPORE (B)

Breakfast & check out. At leisure time till transfer to Da Nang airport back to Singapore on MI639 Dep 1630 hrs
