



# Report on the Annual General Meeting (AGM) Proceedings—Wednesday 11 December 2019

President Deepak Nagrani called the Annual General Meeting (AGM) to order at 8.20pm and it was noted that quorum requirement of 30 members attendance was met (a total of 34 members attended).

**Speaker:** Professor (Prof) David Llewelyn,

Managing Director, David Llewelyn & Co LLc,

Prof (Practice) at SMU's School of Law

**Topic:** "Intellectual Property - What's it all about?"



Before calling on Vocational Service Director Rtn Stuart Pearce to formally introduce the Speaker, President Deepak advised that Prof Llewelyn was an important speaker, and that he attended his classes in Law School and found him very inspiring.

Prof David Llewelyn is a practising lawyer, academic and arbitrator. He is Managing Director of David Llewelyn & Co LLC; Professor (Practice) Singapore Management at University's School of Law and Professor of

Dir Stuart Pearce Intellectual Property Law at King's College London; and sits as an arbitrator in international commercial disputes. He is an IP Adjudicator at the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore and author of leading texts on UK and EU trade marks and intellectual property law, as well as Cases, Materials and Commentary on Singapore Intellectual Property Law (2018) and business book Invisible Gold in Asia: Creating Wealth through Intellectual Property (2010). He has been appointed by the Singapore Court

of Appeal as amicus curiae in cases involving trademarks, copyright and patents.

Prof Llewelyn gave an overview of the main Intellectual property rights such as patents, copyrights, trademarks and designs. He further explained the dangerous misconceptions about intellectual property rights. Prof Llewelyn recounted the interesting stories of several entrepreneurs who successfully copied ideas to become hugely profitable innovators.

President Deepak called upon newly inducted member, Rtn Mahesh Kumar Bolimbala who thanked Prof Llewelyn for his wonderful explanation in simple terms on intellectual property which was very relevant. 


