

President Dinesh called for nominations for the four elected members of the Nominating Committee to consider nominations for President for Rotary Year 2022/23.


He advised that these nominations to the Nominating Committee should be in writing and to be received by 14th August 2020.

No person shall be a member of the nominating committee for more than 3 consecutive years.

If more than four nominations are received, a vote will be held. If the number of nominations is less than four, the Board shall have the power to fill any vacancy.



KNOW YOUR FELLOW ROTARIAN (KYFR)

President Dinesh introduced the first KYFR speaker, none other than Honorary Secretary Brigitte Holtschneider. Rtn Brigitte shared snippets of her life since her birth in Hamburg in 1959. She studied Business Managerial Economics at the Wirtschaftsakademie Hamburg, and soon after graduating, worked at Reemtsma/Imperial Tobacco from 1980 to 2005. Work brought her to many countries, her first project in Asia was in Hong Kong in 1997. She was posted to Moscow in 1999 and subsequently arrived in Singapore in July 2000. She founded her own company, Asian Projects, in 2005 and was the Executive Director of the British Chamber of Commerce from 2007 till 2017.

Rtn Brigitte recalled how she was invited by Rtn Dr Tim Philippi to a Rotary meeting in 2007, where she was inspired by the guest speaker, a nurse, who spoke of her work with HIV patients. Shortly after, Rtn Brigitte advised she was proposed for membership by Rtn Uttam Kripalani. Rtn Brigitte added she was happy to serve as a Board Member again – she was previously CSC Director as well as Vice President. She further

shared her other voluntary work with Aidha as well as Daughters of Tomorrow.

Rtn Brigitte advised that the next KYFR speaker will be International Service Director Varun Gulati followed by Rtn Elizabeth Chee at the weekly meeting of 29 July.

GUEST SPEAKER: DR PARAG KHANNA TOPIC: THE FUTURE OF ASIA IN A POST-COVID WORLD

President Dinesh called upon VP Suresh Keerthi to introduce the Guest Speaker, Dr Parag Khanna who is a leading global strategy advisor, world traveller, and bestselling author. He is Founder and Managing Partner of FutureMap, a data and scenario based strategic advisory firm. Dr Khanna's newest book is The Future is Asian: Commerce, Conflict & Culture in the 21st Century (2019). He is author of a trilogy of books on the future of world order beginning with The Second World: Empires and Influence in the New Global Order (2008), followed by How to Run the World: Charting a Course to the Next Renaissance (2011), and concluding with Connectography: Mapping the Future of Global Civilization (2016). He is also author of Technocracy in America: Rise of the Info-State (2017) and co-author of Hybrid Reality: Thriving in the Emerging Human-Technology Civilization (2012).



Guest Speaker Dr Parag Khanna

Dr Khanna was named one of Esquire's "75 Most Influential People of the 21st Century," and featured in WIRED magazine's "Smart List." He holds a PhD from the London School of Economics, and Bachelors and Masters degrees from the School of Foreign Service at Georgetown University. He has travelled to nearly 150 countries and is a Young Global Leader of the World Economic Forum.

Dr Khanna gave an insightful and eloquent talk on his views on the future of Asia in a post-COVID world, adding that Asia has multiple drivers in its favour. He cited various factors and comparisons on how Regionalization displaces Globalization, i.e. moving towards the North American Union, the next European Union and Asia for Asians. Dr Khanna's talk focussed on Asia's trade and on the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership as well as aspects of China's Foreign Direct Investment. He further spoke of his research on supply chain empires and its historical antecedents and shared his views on the return of Afroeurasia. Following his talk, Dr Khanna was inundated with a myriad of questions which he graciously answered as many as he could during the allotted time frame.

To extend the vote of thanks, President Dinesh invited Rtn Uttam Kripalani who recounted how he first got to know Dr Khanna's father in 1961. Rtn Uttam warmly thanked Dr Khanna for his brilliant talk and added that he looked forward to seeing the results of his predictions particularly in the area of Afroeurasia.


