



NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING (EOGM):

President Dinesh reminded members of the Extraordinary General Meeting to be held on **Wednesday, 29**th **July 2020 at 8.15 pm** for the purpose of considering the Foundation of Rotary Clubs (Singapore) Ltd. ("FRCS") proposal that all Rotarians:

- 1. pledge to participate actively and volunteer in the work of the Host Organisation Committee and

KNOW YOUR FELLOW ROTARIAN

President Dinesh announced the new section of the meeting – KYFR, and that the speaker was International Service Committee (ISC) Director Rtn Varun Gulati, who will speak about his vocation and members would have the opportunity to get to know him better.

Rtn Varun gave an introduction of his family of five with his being the youngest boy born in Delhi in 1983 with 2 sisters, one of whom is a polyglot and the other a doctor. He spoke of his parental influences from his father, an engineer and his mother, an architect in the initial workforce. Rtn Varun shared that he lived in Dubai for 4 years and has been in Singapore for the last 10 years. He further introduced his wife and travel partner, Niharika. Rtn Varun spoke of the "circle of life" of Nature's way of taking and giving back in relation with the loss of his mother and the birth of his daughter, Saige, in 2018, adding that women have played an important role in his life.

Rtn Varun advised that he joined the Club in July 2018, thanks to the influence of Hon. Member Rtn Mohan Vaswani. He further thanked PP Dr Yap Lip Kee who hosted the 1st online ISC meeting on 16.7.2020 at his home. Among his other voluntary work, Rtn Varun advised that he volunteers with Caregivers Alliance and Food from the Heart as well as a strategic adviser to MKAC Foundation. Rtn Varun added that since 2016 he has supported the Movember movement for men's health projects, and last year alone, he raised more than \$5,000. Lastly, Rtn Varun added that for the past 15 years, he had only worked as a banker.

GUEST SPEAKER: MR TEH ENG HUA

TOPIC: WILLING HEARTS - INTRODUCTION, PURPOSE, SUSTAINABILITY

President Dinesh called on Community Service Director Rtn Dr Irina Francken who introduced the Speaker, Mr Teh Eng Hua. Mr Teh is a marine engineer by profession and upon his retirement in 2016 began volunteering with Willing Hearts and in 2018 became its President.

Prior to his talk, Mr Teh showed a heart-warming video highlighting the work that this secular, non-affiliated charity, which is wholly run by volunteers, apart from a handful of staff. Since its humble beginning of collecting and distributing unsold loaves of bread, Willing Hearts now operates a soup kitchen that prepares, cooks and distributes about 8,500 daily meals to over 40 locations island-wide, every day of the year.

Mr Teh spoke of the organisation's volunteer base who come from all walks of life, race and religion to provide meals for the beneficiaries who include the elderly who live alone with no family members, the disabled, lowincome families, children from single-parent families or otherwise poverty-stricken families, and migrant workers in Singapore. Willing Hearts has been extremely helpful during the current COVID situation. After his presentation, Mr Teh graciously answered the questions posed to him by members and guests.

President Dinesh invited PP Perlita who was impressed by Mr Teh's passion and noted that the work undertaken by Willing Hearts resonated with Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self". She added that to feed the number of people mentioned was truly a mind boggling feat. PP Perlita warmly thanked Mr Teh for sharing his story and felt sure that some members would want to help and even bring their children as a form of education for them, and for the elderly to volunteer as a group it might be therapeutic.


